

~ For those who are expected to be unable to receive the fixed amount tax reduction ~

Benefits to counter soaring prices (adjustment benefit) ID17778

Fixed amount tax reduction will be implemented for the income tax and the individual inhabitant tax in 2024. Among those eligible for the fixed tax reduction, for those who are expected to be unable to fully reduce their tax because the amount of the fixed tax reduction exceeds their tax payment, the difference will be paid as a price rise countermeasure benefit.

Eligibility: Those whose individual inhabitant tax are levied in Ikeda in 2024 and whose fixed tax reduction amount calculated based on dependents including taxpayers and their spouses, exceeds their estimated income tax amount in 2024 or individual inhabitant income tax amount in 2024.

* except for those whose total income exceeds 18.05 million yen.

* except for those who don't pay tax on both the income tax amount and the individual inhabitant tax income rate

Procedures: Documents regarding adjustment benefits will be sent to applicable persons at the end of July.

* Procedures are required to receive the benefits.

Nakayoshi will start a meal distribution service that allows children to order lunch during the summer vacation. Orders and payments are made directly with the business person via the Internet. For details, please visit the city's website.

Price 300 yen per meal (tax included)

How to use:

(1) Parents visit the online shop, look at the menu, and purchase a lunch box.

(Various online payments such as credit cards are available)

(2) The purchased lunch box will be delivered to Nakayoshi.

(3) The instructor will serve the lunch boxes to the children.

* Finished tableware will be collected on the same day, considering hygiene.

Revision of the child allowance system ID2450

Due to the partial revision of the Child Allowance Act, the child allowance system will be changed from October, 2024 (paid in December). Around the end of June, we mail documents regarding procedures for child allowance to families with children under high school age (born on or after April 2, 2006) as of April 30. Please check the documents for details, and if you need to complete any procedures, please return the documents or bring them directly to us.

We support women's own way of living and working! ID18196**【Egg Freezing Cost Subsidy Project】**

In order to support women's "own way of living and working" and women's self-selection, we will subsidize the cost of freezing eggs (unfertilized eggs) to prepare for future pregnancy and childbirth. We support diverse lifestyles for women who are struggling to balance their careers and child-rearing by increasing options when to become pregnant.

When considering egg freezing, please carefully read the explanation and watch the video of the website "For those who are considering non-medical egg freezing" by the Japan Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

If you have any questions about pregnancy, childbirth, or childcare, please contact the Children's Future Division.

Eligibility: Women living in Ikeda between the ages of 18 and 39 (age on the day of egg retrieval)

*Those who underwent the egg freezing on or after April 1, 2024.

Subsidy amount: Up to 200,000 yen (the year when the egg freezing was implemented)


From the next year, when storing and updating frozen eggs,
20,000 yen per year (up to 5 years)

Eligible medical treatments: Medications to prepare for egg retrieval, egg retrieval, egg freezing.

* There are conditions for subsidy, such as no delinquent city tax.

Details will be posted on the city's website as soon as decided. (It is subject to change.)

**About abandoned bicycles around the station** ID5479

We designate the area around Hankyu Ikeda Station and Hankyu Ishibashi Handai-mae Station as bicycles no-leave zone. Bicycles and other items left in the area may be moved and stored as they may interfere with the passage of pedestrians and emergency vehicles and or lead to deteriorating public safety.

* Bicycle abandon is where the owner leaves the place and it cannot be moved immediately. In that case, it is designated as "abandon" even for a short time.

Returning date and time: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Monday to Friday)

9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (1st and 3rd Saturday)

Location: City Abandoned Bicycle Storage (1-9-25 Hachizuka)
