★Applications will be accepted from November 1 for new admission and transfer of childcare facilities★ ID18717

We will start accepting new admissions to childcare facilities in April 2025. The application form is distributed at Day Nursery Division or can be downloaded from Ikeda city website.

Target : Families in which parents need childcare due to dual income or illness

Expenses: Childcare fee (free for 3-5 year-olds), school lunch fee (only 3-5 year-olds), personal childcare supplies, etc.

Application: below (1) and (2)

(1) Bring the necessary documents directly to the Day Nursery Division from November 1 (Fri) to December 13 (Fri) (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays)

(2) Day Nursery Division (〒563-8666, no address required),

by delivery record such as a specific record or simple registered mail, from November 1 (Fri) to November 29 (Fri) (postmark valid).

* If you are unable to apply during the period, the secondary application

is available until January 31(Fri), 2025. In addition, those who applied for admission during 2024 and wish to continue after April in 2025 need to apply again. For other details, please refer to the "Childcare Facility Admission Guide" distributed by the department or Ikeda website.

★ Application for membership in Nakayoshi-kai (after school care)★ ID2265

Eligibility: 1st to 4th grade elementary school students whose parents are unable to provide childcare due to work or illness (Children enrolled in special needs classes are up to the 6th grade)

Cost: 6,000 yen per month, 3,000 yen per month for extended childcare

Application: Local Education Division for new members, each Children's Association for enrolled children and their siblings from December 2(Mon) to December 24 (Tue)

* Application forms will be distributed in November at nursery schools, certified children's centers, kindergartens, children's associations, and

the city hall. The admissions will be after May 2025 with the applications after the deadline.



★ Issuance of Myna(my number) Health Insurance Card and Health Insurance Card★ ID18545·18232

(1) Myna Health Insurance Card

You can see doctors using your Myna Card(My Number Card) by registering for use your Myna Card as your health insurance card.

By using the Myna Card as a health insurance card (Myna Health Insurance Card), you can take advantages such as being able to receive better medical care, such as smoothly sharing information on medications that have been prescribed in the past, and not having to pay more than the limit at the counter.

* The Myna Health Insurance Card is available at medical institutions and pharmacies that have introduced an online eligibility verification system.

Stickers and posters of "Myna Reception" are displayed at those institutions that handle it.

You can register your Myna Health Insurance Card on your PC, smartphone, or at a Seven Bank ATM.

(2) Issuance of National Health Insurance and Medical Health Insurance Cards for the Elderly

On December 1, 2024, the issuance (including reissuance) of health insurance cards will be ended for National Health Insurance and medical care for the elderly, but those issued by December 1 can be used until the stated expiration date. (Except in cases where there is a change in the description due to a change in qualifications, etc.)

○ National Health Insurance subscribers

For those who don't have a Myna Health Insurance Card, we will issue a "Certificate of Qualification" in place of the Health Insurance Card.

And for those who do, we will issue a "Notice of Credentials".

Even if you are unable to confirm your eligibility with your Myna Health Insurance Card at medical institutions, you can still see doctors

by presenting your Myna Health Insurance Card and the "Notice of Credentials".

○Elderly subscribers for the medical care system

"Certificate of Eligibility" will be provisionally issued in place of the Health Insurance Card, regardless of the status of the holder of the Myna Health Insurance Card. We will inform you when the interim period ends.
