Support is provided from pregnancy to child raising through health check-ups for expecting and nursing mothers and infants, as well as consultation relating to child raising from nurses and midwives, nutritionists, dental hygienists and so on. Educational classes are also held. (For more information about services please refer to p. 68) <b>Health Promotion Division</b> ☎072-754-6034 (located within the Health and Welfare Center)	Ikeda runs maternity classes and fatherhood preparation workshops (Sundays) aimed at soon-to-be mothers and fathers. The fatherhood preparation workshop requires booking in advance.	Aimed at newborn infants up until 4 months after birth, support is provided through a house visit from a nurse and midwife to check the baby’s weight and health, as well as consultation regarding nursing. Please submit the Birth Record Form (postcard), which is attached separately to the Maternity Health Handbook.	“Gokkun-ki” (gulping period) is a workshop course with taste-testing that teaches about baby food 5-8 months following birth. The “Kamikami-ki” (chewing period) workshop teaches about food diet from 9 months after birth, including cooking classes. The “Kamikami-ki” workshop requires bookings and includes fees for ingredient costs.	Nijihiro is a consultation counter that provides information about child raising. A full-time nurse with experience in local child raising support provides assistance. Please utilize this service in a method that suits you via phone consultation, visiting in person or home visit requests. (Refer to details on p. 99)

The A4 size file can be used to hold your own record sheets and documents given by the hospital. The file is separated into two parts consisting of “face sheets”, demographic questionnaires that can be completed during infant health check-ups, kindergarten and school health check-ups, and at medical institutions, and “My Child Now”, which can be used to record physical movement, communication and matters relating to daily life. ## Satsukiyama Zoo

*The world's most lovable zoo.*

Satsukiyama Greenery Management Center (Zoo)

Satsukiyama Zoo has an area of 4,500m<sup>2</sup>.

There are many sites to see, from rare Australian animals such as wombats and wallabies, to the animal petting corner and much more. Enjoy a relaxing and fun day when you visit the zoo.

## Satsukiyama Children's Cultural Center

A science museum complete with a planetarium. Science experiment workshops and nature viewing events, as well as hand crafting and cooking, outdoors area, puppet plays and concerts, and other events for preschoolers and guardians. The center offers programs focusing on hands on experiences, placing importance on nurturing children's learning and growth.

## Osaka International (Itami) Airport

The airport's 400m long observation deck is a popular spot filled with a sense of freedom, where you can not only see the aircraft's take-off and landing, but also enjoy flowers throughout the seasons.

## Ikeda City Museum of History and Folklore

The museum collects, conserves, investigates and researches materials about Ikeda. It also runs permanent exhibits, temporary and special exhibitions, guest lectures and more.

## Humobility World

*Open to the general public every Saturday*

A history museum opened in celebration of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Daihatsu Motor Co. Ltd. From Daihatsu's beginnings until now, nostalgic cars are displayed alongside background imagery of the era when they were first manufactured. There is also a corner where you can have a go and learn about car and automobile designs through fun games.

## Urban Greenery Botanical Gardens

Beginning with the greenhouse, you can enjoy various gardens exhibiting flowering plants in all four seasons. Throughout the year there are also many exhibitions and workshops held here.

## Ikeda Castle Park

*A place of relaxation and refreshment for Ikeda residents*

The former castle site of the Ikeda family which ruled the region around Ikeda City from the Muromachi period. It was established as a park and opened in April 2000. From the Yagura-style watchhouse, you can take in a panoramic view of not only the city, but also the Hanshin Expressway's Shin-Inagawa Bridge (popularly known as the Big Harp), and the garden grounds.

## Suigetsu Park

A park fondly known for being an oasis of greenery within Ikeda's city area. There is a Chinese-style gazebo and stone monument gifted to Ikeda by our friendship city, Suzhou in China, as well as seasonal flowers such as plum blossoms and Japanese irises for visitors to enjoy.

## Rakugo Museum

Location: Sakaehonmachi 7-3 Tel: 072-753-4440

Ikeda, the "City of Rakugo", was Japan's first city to publically display "Kamigata", Kyoto and Osakan style, Rakugo history and materials since the museums opening in April 2007. There are videos introducing Rakugo, a corner where you can watch your favorite Rakugo performer's CD'S and DVD's, and an exhibit space.

## Ikeda Gofukuza Theater

Constructed in the Meiji period, the well-loved playhouse is host to performances of the popular theatre, Gofukuza. Consisting of plays and extravagant dance shows, performances are held every day, with both matinee and evening showings.

## Kyuanji Temple

Location: Fushiocho 697 Tel: 072-752-1857

The Romon (two-storied gate) is classified as important national cultural property. Its foundations were first laid during the Nara period, with an emphasis on the appreciation of elegance. Kyuanji is well-known as the 12th temple in the Kansai flower temple route. Throughout the seasons flowers bloom in abundance at Kyuanji, giving rise to its other name, "Flower Temple"

- ❶ Install fire alarms to prevent delays in escape.
  - ❷ In order to protect against fires caused by bedding, clothing and curtains, use flame-proof products.
  - ❸ Install fire extinguishers and other firefighting goods for your home in order to put out fires before they spread.
  - ❹ To protect elderly people and those with limited mobility, establish a neighborhood cooperation system.

# 【Crime Prevention】

Call 110 Fast, certain and concise  
Fast and reliable information helps solve incidents without delay.

- What type of incident/accident? → Burglary or theft, robbery, traffic accident, etc.
- Where? → Address, landmark building or intersection, distance from location
- When? → just now or 5 minutes past, approximate timing
- Features of culprit? → sex, physical appearance, clothing and so on, direction of escape
- What is happening now? → current situation of incident/accident
- I am...? → your address, name and phone number

## Protection against Disasters and Crime in Daily Life

### ● Ways to Eliminate Burglary

- ① Lock the front entrance to your home, even during the day.
- ② Even when only going out for a short time, remember to lock-up and let your neighbors know.
- ③ Use a door chain on the front entrance.

### ● How to use a fire extinguisher

There are three marks for different types of fires. Fires are classified into three main categories, the fire extinguishers adaptability to each fire is displayed in 3 marks.

White mark = Normal fires

Mainly fires from wood, paper or cloth, etc.

Yellow mark = Oil fires

Fires from kerosene, gasoline or fats and oils, etc.

Blue mark = Electrical fires

Fires from electrical appliances and machinery (power transformers, motors), etc.

## 【In the Community [Cooperation]】

### Work Together with Everyone

#### ● Voluntary Disaster Prevention Organization activities

“Let’s work together to protect our city”, local citizens have formed voluntary disaster prevention organizations based on self-defense awareness and a sense of community solidarity.

They are generally organized within local areas (community: ranging from residents’ associations and neighborhood association units to elementary school district units, etc.).

In Ikeda, there are 43 voluntary disaster prevention organizations, and local residents run disaster prevention drills, among other activities, aiming to reduce the effects of disasters.

In preparation for the outbreak of and prevention of the spread of disasters, there are everyday activities (activities during normal, non-disaster periods), as well as activities to prevent damage or the spread of damage after a disaster has occurred (activities during disaster periods).

#### ● Efforts to aid those who need support during disaster evacuation

Currently in Ikeda, the Ishibashi Elementary School district area and an area within the Ikeda Elementary School District, have begun efforts to daily watch over those who need support in disaster evacuation and expand the circle of support during disasters. Let’s unite the community and prepare for emergencies.



# 【From the Government [Rescue and Assistance]】

## Pay Attention to News and Information

### Government Emergency Radio for Disaster Prevention (Broadcast System)

In order to transmit emergency information such as the situation during disasters to citizens without delay, schools and other facilities in Ikeda have an emergency government radio for disaster prevention speakers or motor sirens installed. ### Evacuation Advisory Announcements

Each Announcement has an [Alert Level]

In March 2019, the “Guidelines for Evacuation Advisory Announcements” (Cabinet Office) were revised. In order to easily understand evacuation timing, Alert Levels were added to the evacuation information announced in evacuation advisory announcements.

**Alert Levels are separated into 5 levels.**

<b>Alert Level 5</b>	<b>Disaster has already occurred. Take the best action to ensure your safety.</b>
<b>Alert Level 4</b>	The city has officially announced an “Evacuation Advisory” or “Evacuation Order”. All those in affected areas must quickly evacuate the danger zone. If travel to the evacuation area is thought to be dangerous, evacuate to a nearby safe place or somewhere that is safer than inside the building.
<b>Alert Level 3</b>	The city has officially announced to “prepare for evacuation, and to begin evacuation of the elderly and those with special needs”. Those who take time to evacuate, such as the elderly, and those supporting their evacuation, must evacuate the danger zone to a safe place. All other citizens are advised to prepare for evacuation at any time.
<b>Alert Level 2</b>	The Japan Meteorological Agency has announced a Heavy Rain and Flood Warning. Check areas on the hazard map classified as in possible danger, reconfirm evacuation areas, routes and timing, and prepare for evacuation. Make sure to verify your individual evacuation plan.
<b>Alert Level 1</b>	The Japan Meteorological Agency has announced “Early Warning Information (Possibility of Incoming Disaster)”. Pay attention to the most recent disaster prevention weather information and prepare yourself for the possibility of a disaster.

# 【At Home [Self-reliance]】

## Prepare for Emergencies

### Example of Emergency Supply Carry-pack

Approximately 15kg is suggested for men and 10kg for women.

- ☑ 3 days' worth of food and drinking water (3L per day per person)
- ☑ Valuables (bankbook, personal seal (*inkan*), cash, health insurance card, etc.)
- ☑ Household Medicine
- ☑ Helmet
- ☑ Radio
- ☑ Electric torch
- ☑ Spare batteries
- ☑ Candles
- ☑ Change of clothes
- ☑ Disaster safety hood
- ☑ Rain gear
- ☑ First aid supplies and nursing equipment
- ☑ Canned food    ☑ Instant ramen

※Please also bring a mask and thermometer etc. ,  
to prevent the risk of infection.

### Check Evacuation Areas and Routes

Even for the same disaster, the degree of severity can differ depending on the building and where you live. Ikeda's "Hazard Map" lists the school districts on the same page as much as possible, and is structured so that depending on the type of disaster, you can change the page and know what you should be careful of for that type of disaster with one glance.

Check what disasters you should prepare for and organize an evacuation action plan with your family and neighbors, making sure to confirm evacuation areas and routes.

### Example of Emergency Stockpile

Make an emergency stockpile which will last your family for at least 3 days. If you buy a little more ingredients and processed food than usual in preparation and restock what you use, you can make sure that there will always be a fixed amount of food supplies in your home.

- ☑ drinking water    ☑ instant rice    ☑ instant foods

### Confirm Contact Methods and Meeting Locations

Discuss in advance with your family and friends about contact methods and meeting locations during disasters, so that even if you are separated when a disaster occurs, you can confirm each other's safety. If you have difficulties connecting with your phone or cell phone during a disaster, please use the following services.

#### NTT Disaster Message Dial

If you phone 171 directly, you can leave a recorded message, and family members and those who know your phone number will be able to listen to it.

※This service can be used on home phones, public telephones, some types of IP phones and cell phones (mobile phones).

#### Disaster Message Display Board "web171"

Access the internet from your smart phone or cell phone and leave a text message. Family members and those who know your phone number will be able to view the message.

# 【MY TIMELINE in Preparation for Disasters】

## What is My Timeline?

A personal disaster prevention plan organized in advance with step-by-step actions that you and your family should take, such as; “when?”, “who?” and “what to do?” during storm and flood damage caused by typhoons, heavy rain and other disasters. Because the necessary steps are clear, independent action can be taken quickly. The timing of steps and a contact system can also be decided in advance.

# Improving Disaster Response and Crime Prevention Systems

## Disaster Cooperation with Yahoo!

In order to ensure stable access to the city website and facilitate fast communication of information during disasters, Ikeda has an agreement on the “Transmission of Information During Disasters” with Yahoo! Japan Cooperation. During a disaster, emergency information such as the opening of emergency shelters will be transmitted through the “Yahoo! Disaster Emergency Information” application.



## Announcement of Crime over the Government Emergency Radio for Disaster Prevention

Striving for the safety and security of local residents, there is an agreement with the Ikeda Police on the “use of the Government Emergency Radio for Disaster Prevention to announce crime occurrence and information”. According to this agreement, the following types of crime occurrence information will be announced over the Government Emergency Radio for Disaster Prevention.

(1) When grave or emergency situations in which a local resident’s life, physical body or property is in danger have occurred.

- a. Random attack or murder incident
- b. Chance of consecutive occurrences of murder or theft, etc.
- c. Sighting of a suspicious person carrying a dangerous weapon, etc.

(2) Other situations when deemed as necessary for the safety and security of local residents by Ikeda City or the Ikeda Police Department.

## Use “An-machi” (Safe City) Mail

Set up the receiving time, information categories and area to receive warning information about communications fraud and other crimes in real time from the police.

## Ways to Get Information During a Disaster

### ● Emergency Information (Area) Mail

Emergency Advisories and emergency information is transmitted simultaneously to all cell (mobile) phones (Docomo, SoftBank, au and Rakuten service providers) accompanied by a warning sound (the warning sound will alert even in silent mode).

### ● Power Outage Information

Information about electrical power outages in the Kansai area can be accessed from the application.

A portal site to provide damage and emergency information for weather-related, earthquake and disaster occurrences. There is also an email service available.

# Evacuation Areas During Disasters

Evacuation areas vary depending on the situation and type of disaster.

The city will make an announcement about the designated evacuation shelters to be used in accordance with the situation of the disaster.

DESIGNATED EVACUATION SHELTERS	<p>People in danger from disaster are requested to evacuate to and remain in evacuation shelters until the disaster has passed. Those who are unable to return home due to the disaster, can temporarily reside in the shelters.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Evacuation shelters for use vary depending on the situation and type of disaster.</li><li>● The city will announce the designated evacuation shelters to open in accordance to the situation of the disaster.</li></ul>
DESIGNATED EMERGENCY EVACUATION SITES	<p>When a disaster strikes, or if there is a chance of disaster occurring, emergency evacuation areas are places to escape from the danger.</p>

## 【Family Register (*Koseki*) Notifications】

The Family Register (*Koseki*) is important certification in which the family relationship of a person from birth to death is registered.

Family Register (*Koseki*) notifications are processed at the Registered Location of Permanent Domicile (*Honsekichi*) or the current municipality of residence, however necessary items and documentation, as well as the notification period varies depending on the notification type. Please take note. To prevent identity theft, identity verification is conducted. Please bring identification such as your driver's license, passport, health insurance card and other such documentation to the application counter.

Forms for notifications are available from the General Services Division on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the city hall.

## 【Residential Notifications】

The Certificate of Residence (Basic Resident Register) is an important record of that individual's place of residence which becomes the basis of many administrative affairs such as national health insurance and pension, welfare, health, education, elections when certified. If there are any changes to it, please submit a notification. In order to prevent against fraud, proof of identification of the person making the submission at the counter will be verified. When visiting the counter, please bring identifying documentation with the name and address included, such as a driver's license, passport or health insurance card. Power of attorney is required if the person making the submission is not the applicant themselves or someone in the same household.

## Personal Seal (*Inkan*) Registration

### 【Personal Seal (*Inkan*) Registration Application】

A personal seal or *Inkan* is used widely in everyday life, such as for real estate registration and money loans. Registration of an “Official Registered Seal” (*jitsuin*) is required for official use. The applicant must complete the personal seal (*inkan*) registration application personally. If someone other than the registering person submits the application, they must bring a hand written document from the applicant verifying the intent of authorization (Letter of power of attorney or an Appointment of Representation notification) to the counter for submission. After registration, the personal seal (*inkan*) registration (card) will be handed over. This is necessary for issuance of the Certificate of Personal Seal (*inkan*) Registration. Please keep it safe.

## 【Wide Area Issue of Certificate of Residence】

By using the Basic Resident Register Network System (Juki Net), Certificates of Residence can be obtained in municipalities outside of Ikeda. Application is limited to the applicant themselves or someone of the same household who is included in the Certificate of Residence. Copies of Certificates of Residence which include the registered permanent domicile (*Honseki*) and head of the household, copies of the

record of removed residences and copies of original Certificates of Residence cannot be issued.

- The applicant themselves or someone of the same household, as listed in the Certificate of Residence, must submit the application at the service counter in the desired municipality.
- Please present an officially issued personal identification document with a photograph included, such as a My Number Card, Driver's License or Passport at the service counter.
- The handing fee differs depending on the issuing organization.
- In Ikeda, issue of Wide Area Certificates of Residence has a fee of ¥300 per copy.
- There are cases where residential address cannot be verified.

### **【Regarding Personal Identification】**

In accordance with the partial amendment of the Family Registration Law and Basic Resident Registration Law, when submitting notifications regarding the Family Register (*Koseki*) such as marriage registration, official divorce registration, and notifications regarding the change of residence, such as moving-out, moving-in and change of residence notifications, as well as when applying for various certifications, presentation of personal identification documentation is necessary.

Please present government issued licenses, permits or qualification certificates with a photograph included, such as a Driver's license, passport, Basic Resident Register Card (with photograph), My Number Card, Intellectual Disability Certificate, Residence (*Zairyu*) Card, Special Permanent Resident Certificate or Physical Disability Certificate. In the case of government issued personal identification without a photograph, such as a National Health Insurance Card, Health Insurance Card, National Pension Certificate, or certification issued by non-government institutions, presentation of the personal identification may be accompanied with some questions to verify identity.

All registered residents of Ikeda who are not covered by their workplaces' employee health insurance plan or the medical care system for the latter-stage elderly, or otherwise receiving Public Assistance, must join the National Health Insurance System.

## **【Certificates Confirming Municipal Tax Payments and More】**

When applying for issuance of municipal tax declaration certificates, or requesting an inspection of the fixed property tax ledger please inquire at the Taxation Division. When applying for issuance of tax payment certificates, please inquire at the Tax Collection Division.

## **●Who can Apply**

- Individual themselves (including inheritors or person managing tax payment)
- Representative of individual with a letter of power of attorney, notification of appointment or letter of consent
- Spouse or family member of the same household finances with proof of request from the individual themselves.
- In the case of corporations, an agent with the right of representation, or one of the following; letter of power of attorney, notification of appointment, or letter of consent.

※Tenants and leaseholders with a connection to the fixed property can apply for the inspection and valuation of the fixed property tax ledger, as well as issuance of taxes and public dues certificates (tenants are requested to bring along the contract of lease).

※It is necessary to present personal identification (driver's license, health insurance card, etc.).

※In cases when the taxpayer is a corporation, a stamp of the representative's seal is required.

※Inspection and viewing during the inspection period (every year from April 1 to the first tax payment deadline of that year, not including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays) is free of charge.

※Tax payment certificates for the light vehicle tax (separated by type) continual inspection (vehicle inspection) are free of charge.

## 【Regarding Falling Behind in Municipal Tax Payments and Late Fees】

If the full payment of taxes is not made before the tax payment deadline, arrears will be charged for the unpaid period, from the following day until date of payment in accordance with the Local Tax Law. When the tax payment deadline passes, a reminder notice and tax payment demand will be sent out. If failure of payment continues, following an audit on property, disposition for failure to pay taxes, such as requisition, will take place.

### ●Parent Children’s Bonding DAY

Every Saturday at bathhouses within the city (4 locations), one adult and one child can visit together for just ¥400.

### ●Child Raising Support Pamphlet

Find out with one glance about child raising information and inquiries. Information about child raising support places with the “Ichigo Support Group” and separate elementary school districts, as well as child raising information with “Su-Kids Ikeda”, and so on is distributed in this pamphlet.

### ●Pregnancy, Birth and Child Raising Support Assistance

Aiming to reduce the financial burden on families from pregnancy and birth, to the child raising period, the interest on Senshu Ikeda Bank’s “<Senshu Ikeda> Pregnancy and Child Raising Support Loan” will be partially subsidized.

### 【Child Rearing Allowance】

As a general rule, payments for the Child Rearing Allowance and other such benefits, will be provided for from the month after initial application. However, even if it is in the following month, if the application is completed within 15 days of birth or transfer, payment can be received from the month of application. If the application is late, generally you will not be able to receive the allowance for that month.

### ●Children Eligible for the Allowance

Children up until graduation from junior high school (until March the 31<sup>st</sup> following their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday).

※ Government employees will receive the payment from their workplace.

### ●Allowance Amount

Child's Age	Allowance Amount (per child per month)
Less than 3 years old	¥15,000
Over 3 years old until completion of elementary school	¥10,000 (¥15,000 for the 3 <sup>rd</sup> child onwards)
Junior high school students	¥10,000

※ If the income of the person(s) raising the child exceeds the income limit, as an exceptional payment, the monthly allowance will be ¥5000 for children of all ages.

※ The 3<sup>rd</sup> child onwards will be counted as a child being raised until graduation from high school (until March the 31<sup>st</sup> following their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday).

### ●Current Situation Report

All those receiving the Child Rearing Allowance must submit a Current Situation Report in June each year.

### ●When Notification is Necessary

- Following birth and when the number of children you are raising changes
- After divorce and if the person(s) raising the child changes
- Recipient and child move into or out of Ikeda
- In the case of recipient becoming a government employee, or ceasing government employment.

Application is also necessary if there are any changes in the recipient or child's address, name, or Individual Number, or if you wish to change the bank account for transfer of the allowance.

## Childcare and Nursery Schools

Childcare is available for infants aged from 57 days after birth to children before entering elementary school (Over 3 months for Kosei Nursery School and Kirakira Nursery School, over 6 months for Midorigaoka Nursery School, Wakuwaku Nursery School, Satsuki Nursery School and Ishibashi Bunka Nursery School, and over 3 years for Ishibashi Bunka Kindergarten), whose parents or guardians are unable to care for them due to work or illness.

Enrolment information will be released in the city news magazine and other sources.

◎**Day Care Hours** 7:00 am~7:00 pm (Soen Nursery School is until 8:00 pm, Kamenomori Kindergarten and Day Care, and Ikeda Asahigaoka Kindergarten and Day Care are from 7:30 am~6:30 pm, Ishibashi Bunka Kindergarten and Ishibashi Bunka Nursery School are from 7:30 am~7:00 pm).

◎**Fees** Day care fees are determined by the child's age and guardian's municipal tax income bracket (0 to 2 year olds only, fees for 3 to 5 year olds are free).  
Lunch fees (3 to 5 year olds), etc.

## 【Enrolling in Childcare】

Enrolment into childcare facilities is separated into two main categories.

①Enrolment in nursery schools, small-scale childcare establishments and certified kodomo-en (day care section)

②Enrolment in kindergartens and certified kodomo-en (kindergarten section)

【2】Ikeda City will conduct admittance regulation considering the applicants wishes and childcare situation, etc.

Partial subsidy of self-funded medical expenses using health insurance is provided for those with physical disability certificates class I or II, intellectual disability certificate type A, intellectual disability certificate type B1 together with a physical disability certificate, health benefits certificate for the mentally ill class I, or designated incurable disease (specific untreatable disease) beneficiary certificate holders eligible for the class I disability pension (or Special Child Support Allowance). There is an income limit.

### ●Financial Aid for Medical Treatment Aimed at Improving Independence (Rehabilitation)

When those over 18 years old who have a physical disability certificate receive medical treatment to reduce the impact of their disability or improve their functionality at

specified medical institutions, the medical treatment cost will be paid. As a general rule, one tenth of the cost will be self-funded, however depending on income there is an upper limit to self-funded expenses. Should the Municipal Resident's Tax (income-based levy) amount exceed ¥235,000, you will not be eligible to receive the benefit.

### ●Subsidies

#### ●Housing Renovation Subsidy

Aimed at households with a person under 64 years of age who has a severe disability (physical disability class I or II, severe intellectual disability), expenses for reformation to eliminate differences in levels (steps), etc. will be partially subsidized (a limit on the payment amount

exists). There is an income limit.

Not including additions or repairs to new buildings.

#### ●Car Remodeling Subsidy

When those with a serious physical disability (physical disability class I or II) affecting the function of their upper limbs, lower limbs or torso remodel their car for purposes such as going to work, the expenses will be partially subsidized (a limit on the payment amount exists). There is an income limit.

#### ●Prosthetics, Supportive Devices and Daily Equipment Benefit

##### ◎Prosthetics and Supportive Devices

The expense of purchasing or repairing prosthetics and supportive devices for those with a physical disability certificate and patients with incurable diseases who need a prosthetic or supportive device to help with their disabilities will be paid.

There is a standard amount for each type of prosthetic or supportive device and as a general rule one tenth of the expenses must be self-funded (free for households on Public Assistance and tax-exempt households). The individual themselves, as well as household members whose Municipal Residents Tax amount is less than ¥460,000 are eligible.

Not including equipment for medical treatment or assistive equipment covered by long-term care insurance.

##### ◎Daily Equipment

Expenses for daily equipment and items which are required to make everyday life easier for those with serious physical disabilities and patients with incurable diseases will be paid. There is a standard amount and as a general rule one tenth of the equipment expense must be self-funded (free for households on public assistance and tax-exempt households).



The individual themselves, as well as household members whose Municipal Residents Tax amount is less than ¥460,000 are eligible

#### ●Daily Equipment Benefit for Children with Chronic Diseases

The expenses of daily equipment will be paid for children with chronic diseases who are recipients of the chronic diseases in childhood medical examination certificate and currently residing at home. Depending on the household's income tax situation, some expenses may be self-funded.

Held in cooperation with the Ikeda Dental Association, dental examinations for those with cerebral palsy or hearing disabilities together with a physical disability certificate class I to IV, as well as those with an intellectual disability certificate class A or B1 who have difficulty in general examinations are available.

### ●Transportable Bathing Service for People with Disabilities

A special purpose bathing car will be dispatched for those who find bathing difficult due to severe physical disabilities.

### ●Higher Vocational Training Promotion Benefit

Should a parent from a single parent household wish to gain education at a training institution to receive a qualification

(with training for longer than one year) linked to finding employment as a nurse, physiotherapist, occupational therapist or other similar higher vocation, a benefit to provide for partial living expenses for a fixed period time is available.

### ●High School Graduate Level Education Recognition Examination Support

Parents and children of single parent households who did not graduate from high school can receive partial subsidies on fees for short courses to pass the High School Graduate Level Education Recognition Examination with the aim to achieve independence and stability in everyday life. (Before beginning, it is necessary to complete application procedures for the designated course.)

### ●Admission into Single Mother Daily Life Support Facilities

Educative classes are held about promotion of health and prevention of lifestyle related diseases, dental and oral care, nutrition and exercise, and much more.

#### ◎Health Consultation

- Health consultation from public health nurses, nationally certified nutritionists, dental hygienists and other health professionals is available.
- Citizen health consultation is conducted via appointment by a physician (internal medicine specialist) once a month. For more details, please see the Ikeda Public Information magazine (*ikeda kohoshi*) and the “Guide to Health Services” (*hoken jigyo no goanna*).

#### ◎Public Health Nurse Home Visit Guidance

Home visits aimed at 40 to 60 year olds not eligible for long-term care insurance which provide consultation about prevention of lifestyle related diseases, recovery at home and more.

#### ●Health for Pregnant Women and Infants

##### ◎Issuance of Pregnancy Notice and Maternity Health Handbook

If you are pregnant, please submit the

notice as soon as possible. Pregnant women will be given the Maternity Health Handbook (*boshi kenko techo*) and Pregnancy Health Examination Registration Card (*ninpu kenko shinsa jushinhyo*).

#### ◎Pregnancy Health Examinations

Make sure to have regular health examinations at a medical institution in order to ensure a healthy pregnancy and birth.

Please bring the Pregnancy Health Examination Registration Card, which is in the Maternity Health Handbook additional booklet, with you to the examination.

#### ◎Parenting Classes

Maternity classes and fatherhood preparation workshops are available. The classes will be introduced when you are issued with the Maternity Health Handbook.

#### ◎Hearing Test for Newborn Infants

The cost of hearing tests for newborn infants at the hospital or institution of birth will be partially subsidized. Please use the Pregnancy Health Examination Registration Card in the Maternity Health Handbook additional booklet.

#### ◎“Hello Baby” Home Visit

Regardless of whether it is your first birth or not, a midwife and public health nurse will do home visits for all babies. Please submit the Birth Contact Form (*shussan renrakuhyo*) in the Maternity Health Handbook additional booklet.

#### ◎Vaccinations

In order to protect children against infectious diseases, in accordance with vaccination laws, vaccinations for BCG, measles and rubella, Japanese encephalitis, and more are carried out.

## ◎Infant Health Examinations

### • Group Health Examinations

Health examinations are held for 4 month old infants, 1 year and 6 month old and 3 years and 6 month old children. Those applicable to the 2 year and 6 month old dental health examination will be individually notified.

### • Individual Health Examinations

The registration card for the infant general health examination is in the Maternity Health Handbook additional booklet which is provided when the notification of pregnancy is submitted.

## ◎Baby Food Workshop Course

“*Gokkun-ki*” (gulping period) and “*Kamikami-ki*” (chewing period) workshops are held. Information about dates and applications will be available in the Ikeda Public Information magazine (*ikeda kohoshi*) and the Health Services Guide (*hoken jigyo no goanna*).

## ◎Dental Health

### • Good Teeth Educational Class (*yoi ha no kyoshitsu*)

Discussion about dental and oral health of young children as well as completion of the registration process for fluoride treatment. Information about dates will be available in the Ikeda Public Information magazine (*ikeda kohoshi*) and the Health Services Guide (*hoken jigyo no goanna*).

### • Fluoride Treatment for Young Children (charges apply)

Dental examination, brushing, flossing and fluoride treatment for young children (attendees of the Good Teeth Educational Class) aged between from the month they turn one year old, until the month they become seven years old.

## 【Subsidies】

### ●Infertility Treatment Subsidy

If a woman is able to become pregnant, however experiences miscarriage and stillbirth multiple times, it is classified as infertility. In order to reduce the financial burden on couples receiving infertility treatment, treatment expenses not covered by the national health insurance will be partially subsidized. ### ●Ikeda Subsidy for Re-inoculation of Routine Vaccinations

If the immunity gained from routine vaccinations is reduced or lost due to hematopoietic stem cell transplantation (bone marrow transplants, etc.) or chemotherapy for treatment of cancer, etc. and revaccination is deemed necessary, a subsidy is available for the vaccination expense.

## 【Children's Medical Subsidy】

Following application, a Children's Medical Care Certificate will be issued. When hospitalized or attending medical institutions as an outpatient, the self-funded medical expense not covered by the national health insurance will be partially subsidized.

### ●Target

- Children who are registered residents up until the age of 18 (March 31 following their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday).
- Enrolled in various health insurance systems
- Children not receiving government funded medical subsidies from other systems.

### ●Subsidy Contents

- Medical expenses from hospitalization and outpatient treatment

※However, expenses not covered by the National Health Insurance, such as vaccination fees, medical health examination fees and cost of containers for medicine, as well as meal expenses during hospitalization and psychiatric hospitalization expenses (including transitional measures) are not included in the subsidy.

## ◎Concerning Partial Self-funded Payment

○ By presenting your Health Insurance Card and Medical Care Certificate, ¥500 per day (up 2 days a month) for the hospitalization or outpatient treatment of one month must be paid per medical institution. From the third day onwards, there are no self-funded expenses.

○ If the self-funded expense for one time is less than ¥500, the expense will be fully self-funded.

○ If the medical institution changes or there are dental and non-dental medical expenses at the same medical institution, expenses will be charged the same and require self-funded payment.

○ Expenses for hospitalization and outpatient treatment at the same medical institution will be charged separately and require self-funded payment.

○ There is no self-funded payment for prescription medicine bought at pharmacies outside the hospital.

※Medical care certificates can only be used at medical institutions within Osaka prefecture. If you receive treatment at a hospital outside the prefecture, present only your health insurance card and afterwards apply for a subsidy on the fee difference (for more details, please see the “When to Apply for Medical Welfare Subsidy” section).

## ◎Reimbursement of Partial Self-funded Payment

If you receive treatment at multiple medical institutions within a month and the partial self-funded payment exceeds a total of ¥2,500, the difference will be reimbursed following registration of a bank account. Once a bank account has been registered, any reimbursement money will be automatically transferred into the account from the next time onwards.

## ●Necessary Items for the Medical Care Certificate Application

- Health Insurance Card (A health insurance card with your child's name included on it)
  - Guardians who have moved to Ikeda require their most recent Income Certificate
- ※Not including those who complete the application in Ikeda.

## ●Using the Medical Care Certificate

The certificate can be used from the first day of the application month. However, if the child is just born or you have recently moved to Ikeda, the certificate can be used from the date of the child's birth or date of moving to Ikeda.

## ●When to Apply for Medical Welfare Subsidy (This month's medical treatment expenses will be reimbursed from the next month onwards)

- When hospitalized or out-patient treatment is received outside of Osaka prefecture
- When you receive medical treatment after only presenting your Health Insurance Card (when unable to present Medical Care Certificate)
- When medical expenses are incurred from health insurance (cost of supportive devices, etc.)

※When hospitalized or in other such situations with eligibility to receive the "High Medical Expense and Medical Treatment Subsidy of Family Dependents", etc., however the payment is processed with a health insurance card not enrolled in the system, application to receive reimbursement is required, together with the payment receipt.

## ◎Necessary Items and Documents

- Health Insurance Card
- Children's Medical Care Certificate
- Personal Seal (*inkan*)
- Invoice receipt (document of a medical expense which is covered by the insurance with the name of the child receiving medical treatment, insurance points and date. If the document is a sales receipt, written detail of the patient name at the medical institution, insurance points and date are required.)
- Documentation with bank account information

## ◎Notification of Change in Circumstances

In the following situations, please bring your health insurance card and submit a notification as soon as possible.

Please be aware that if the notification is delayed, medical expenses may need to be returned.

- Moving away from Ikeda
- Moving to a different residence within Ikeda
- The eligible recipient dies
- The type of health insurance card or information the card changes
- Become eligible to receive Public Assistance
- Receive injury due to the actions of a third party (such as a traffic accident) and receive medical treatment
- There is a change in the household structure

# Senior Citizens and Nursing Care

## Senior Citizens

### **【Latter-stage Elderly Medical Insurance System】**

In order for senior citizens to have worry-free access to medical treatment, the Latter-stage Elderly Medical Insurance System was established to have general citizens to support the medical treatment of elderly citizens over 75 years old. Under the system medical treatment costs, excluding the self-funded general service expense, will be funded by public expenditure (approximately 50%), support funds from the working generation (approximately 40%) and the contribution of insured persons (approximately 10%). The Latter-stage Elderly Medical Insurance System is managed by the Osaka Prefecture Wide Area Union for the Medical Care of the Latter-stage Elderly. The collection of insurance contributions, as well as general services for various applications is managed at each municipality.

### **●Eligibility**

Citizens are automatically enrolled in the system on their 75<sup>th</sup> birthday, so application is not required. However, when changing from employee insurance (employee health insurance, etc.) to the Latter-stage Elderly Medical Health Insurance, dependent family members less than 75 years old will be required to separately complete an application to enter into the National Health Insurance (those older than 65, but younger than 75 years old who have certain disabilities can apply to enroll in the Latter-stage Elderly Medical Health Insurance System). Those who receive social welfare cannot enter into the Latter-stage Elderly Medical Health Insurance System.

### **●Treatment at Medical Institutions**

The self-funded expense for treatment at medical institutions is one tenth (10%) for general insured persons and three tenths (30%) for active income earners. The self-funded expense percentage is renewed in August each year and determined by the income during the previous year.

# Long-term Care Insurance

## 【Enrollment in Long-term Care Insurance and Insurance Fees】

When nursing care becomes necessary (those over 65 year old or medically insured persons over 40 years old with one of sixteen specified illnesses related to aging) submit the application through Ikeda to receive a certification of necessary nursing care (necessary support) to use long-term care insurance services.

### ●Type 1 Insured: Over 65 Years Old

The contribution amount is determined based on the calculated average to cover nursing care service expenses. There are different set contribution amounts depending on income. The contribution will be deducted in advance from the pension for those who receive a yearly pension of ¥180,000 or more, all others can pay by payment slip or direct bank transfer.

### ●Type 2 Insured: 40-64 Years Old

Determination and payment of the contribution depends on the type of medical insurance.

#### ◎National Health Insurance

Determined based on income and number of 40-65 year old persons in the household eligible for the long-term care insurance. The head of the household pays contribution for the medical benefit, latter-stage elderly support money and nursing care contribution together as part of the national health insurance contribution.

#### ◎Employee Health Insurance Plan

Determined based on the health insurance plan calculation method of the health insurance society, mutual aid association, or other insurer of enrollment. The contribution for medical benefit and nursing care are combined and deducted from the salary as a part of the health insurance contribution. ## 【From Application to Notification of Result】

### ●Application

The application counter is the Long-term Health Insurance System counter on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the city hall. The applicant themselves or a family member, community general support center or home nursing care staff acting on behalf of the applicant must submit the application to the city.

### ●Nursing Care Requirement Certification

Upon application, based on the results of a home examination and letter of opinion from the doctor, an official review will be carried out and a decision will be made; determining the degree of necessity for nursing care and support (nursing care level).

### ●Notification of Result

The notification will generally arrive within 30 days of making the application. Depending on the nursing care level, the available services and monthly expense limit on the long-term care insurance varies.

〈Nursing Care Level I~V〉 Nursing Care Service

〈Support Care I, II〉 Long-term preventative care services, long-term preventative care, daily life general support services

## 【Nursing Care Service】

A service for those with nursing care level I ~V certification. Please choose from either the at-home care or facility care service.

### ●At-home Care Service

Decide on and form an agreement with a designated home nursing care worker, and make a care plan together. Based on this plan, make an agreement with a service provider and begin using the service.

#### ◎Consultation (at-home nursing care support)

Among other services, you can make a care plan with the care manager with the aim of relieving and reassuring users of care services.

#### ◎Home Visit Care

A home helper visits the home and provides physical care and support with daily life.

#### ◎Home Visit Bathing Care

A transportable bathing car visits the home and provides assisted bathing care.

#### ◎Home Visit Rehabilitation

A specialist visits the home and provides rehabilitative care.

#### ◎At-home Medical Care Management Advice

Doctors, dentists, pharmacists and other specialists visit the home and provide medical management and advice such as how to take medicine, meals and more.

#### ◎Home Visit Nursing

Nurses and such visit the home and inspect the patient's condition, treating bedsores and other conditions.

#### ◎Facility Visit Care

Receive nursing care services such as meals and bathing, as well as everyday movement training during the day at day service centers of 19 attendees or more.

#### ◎Facility Visit Rehabilitation

Receive rehabilitation and more during the day at a health care facility for the elderly requiring long-term care or other such facility

#### ◎Short Term Admittance into Daily Care

Be admitted for a short period to a health care facility for the elderly requiring long-term care or other such facility and receive nursing care assistance with meals, bathing, going to the toilet and other services, as well as functional training.

#### ◎Short Term Admission into Medical Care

Be admitted for a short period to a health care facility for the elderly requiring long-term care or other such facility and receive nursing, care and functional training under medical management.

#### ◎Daily Care for Special Facility Residents

Persons admitted into designated paid elderly nursing homes or other such facilities can receive necessary nursing care services from the facility.

#### ◎Allowance for Purchase of Special Assistive Equipment

#### ◎Loan of Assistive Equipment

#### ◎Home Renovation Allowance

## ●Community-based Services

### 〈Small Scale Multifunctional At-home Nursing Care〉

With a focus on facility visits, this multifunctional care service also provides home visit and overnight stay services.

### 〈Small Scale Multifunctional At-home Care and Nursing〉

A service combining small scale multifunctional at-home nursing care with home nurse visits, providing comprehensive care from care workers and nurses.

### 〈Facility Nursing Care for People with Dementia〉

Daily life care, functional training and more is provided at day nursing care facilities for elderly people affected by dementia.

### 〈Communal Daily Living Care for People with Dementia (Group Home)〉

Communal living residence for elderly people affected by dementia. Daily life care, functional training and more is provided.

### 〈Social Welfare for those Admitted into Community-based Welfare Facilities for the Elderly Requiring Long-term Care〉

Eligible to those with nursing care level certification of III or more who are unable to be cared for at home. Assistance with daily life, including meals, bathing and going to the toilet, as well as health management as more is provided.

### 〈Community-based Special Daily Care Facilities〉

Eligible to those with nursing care level I certification or more. Small scale (max. 29 people), paid elderly nursing homes which provide assistance with daily life, including meals, bathing and going to the toilet, as well as functional training and health management.

### 〈Routine Inspection and On-call Home Visit Nursing and Care〉

Routine home visits are conducted by care workers and registered nurses day and night. If necessary a contacting device which is distributed in advance to users of the service can be used to contact an operator from whom on-call home visits and response is provided.

### 〈Community-based Facility Visit Nursing Care〉

Eligible to those with nursing care level certification of I or more. Day care services of a capacity of 18 people or less, provide daily assistance with meals, bathing, going to the toilet, as well as functional training.

## ●Facility Services

Apply for entry and make a contract with a long-term care insurance (nursing care) facility.

### 〈Welfare Facility for the Elderly Requiring Long-term Care〉

Eligible to those with nursing care level III certification or more, who cannot be cared for at home. Daily nursing care such as meals, bathing and going to the toilet, as well as health management support is provided.

### 〈Health Care Facility for the Elderly Requiring Long-term Care〉

Aimed at those with a stable condition, for whom nursing care with an emphasis on rehabilitation is deemed necessary. Nursing care and rehabilitation under medical administration, as well as assistance in daily life is provided.

### 〈Sanatorium-type Medical Care Facility for the Elderly Requiring Long-term Care〉

Aimed at those with a stable condition following acute medical treatment who require recuperative treatment over a long period of time. A medical facility (hospital) adapted towards long-term care, medical treatment, nursing care and more is provided.

### 〈Integrated Facility for Medical and Long-term Care〉

A facility that accepts intensive nursing patients who require daily medical management, as well as providing care for the sick and terminally ill with combined live-in facilities.

### ●Nursing Care Service Expenses

#### ◎At-home Services

The upper expense limit per month is determined by the required nursing care level. 10-30% of the expenses will be self-funded for use of the services within these boundaries. Any expenses exceeding the monthly limit will be fully self-funded.

#### ◎Facility Services

10-30% of the expense for facility services, as well as the sum of residence, meal and everyday life expenses will be self-funded.

※ The residence cost varies depending on the type of facility and room. The actual cost of the residence and meals is based on the contract between the patient and facility. In addition, there is a set self-funded expense limit for those with low income, any expense exceeding this will be withdrawn from long-term care insurance.

### ◎Payment of High Cost Nursing Care Service Expenses

Should the 10-30% self-funded expense be considerably high, costs exceeding a determined amount will be paid for.

### ◎Payment of High Cost Combined Medical and Long-term Care Expenses

Regarding households with those entered into the same long-term care insurance, should the self-funded expense of the combined medical and long-term care expenses of the household be considerably high, costs exceeding a determined amount will be paid for.

### 【Long-term Preventative Care Services】

Services for those with support care level I or II certification. Establish daily life goals and make use of the services.

### ●Steps to Using Services

#### ◎Contact and Consultation

Please contact a community general support center, facilities aimed at providing necessary general support to improve the lifestyle, physical and mental health of senior citizens in the community. Public health nurses and senior care managers will explain the services contents and provide consultation.

#### ◎Create a Long-term Preventative Care Plan

Consult with public health nurses and senior care managers to establish lifestyle goals and create a Long-term Preventative Care Plan.

### ◎Using Services

Choose the service provider, form a contract, and use the service according to the Long-term Preventative Care Plan. 10-30% of expenses will be self-funded.

### ◎Evaluation and Review

After a determined time period has passed an evaluation of whether the goals have been reached or not will be conducted. A decision will be made as to whether continued use of the long-term preventative care service is necessary.

### ●Types of Long-term Preventative Care Services

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care Support

Public health nurses and other staff at community general support centers focus on creating long-term preventative care plans and providing support related to long-term preventative care.

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care Home Visit Rehabilitation

Specialists instruct patients on physical exercises and such that they can do by themselves.

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care At-Home Medical Care Management Guidance

Doctors, dentists, pharmacists and more provide instruction on medical care management such as how to take medicine and meals as a means of long-term preventative care.

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care Registered Nurse Home Visit

Registered nurses and more conduct home visits and provide medical care and necessary medical assistance as means of long-term preventative care.

### ◎Rehabilitation at Facilities for Long-term Preventative Care

Physiotherapy, occupational therapy, rehabilitation and other rehabilitative care is provided during day visits at Health Care Facilities for the Elderly Requiring Long-term Care as means of long-term preventative care.

#### ◎Short-term Admission Daily Nursing Care for Long-term Preventative Care

Short-term admission into Welfare Facilities for the Elderly Requiring Long-term Care to receive support with daily life including meals and bathing as well as functional training as means of long-term preventative care.

#### ◎Short-term Admission Medical Care for Long-term Preventative Care

Short-term admission into Health Care Facilities for the Elderly Requiring Long-term Care to receive nursing, as well as nursing care, functional training and more under medical administration as means of long-term preventative care.

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care Allowance for Purchase of Special Assistive Equipment

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care Loan of Assistive Equipment

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care Home Renovation Allowance

#### ◎Long-term Preventative Care for Special Facility Residents

Persons admitted into designated paid elderly nursing homes or other such facilities can receive necessary nursing care services from the facility.



## ◎Community-based Long-term Preventative Care Services

### 〈Small Scale Multifunctional At-home Nursing Care for Long-term Preventative Care〉

With a focus on facility visits, this multifunctional care service also provides home visit and overnight stay services aimed at long-term preventative care.

### 〈Long-term Preventative Care Facility Nursing Care for People with Dementia〉

Daily life care, functional training and more aimed at long-term preventative care is provided at day nursing care facilities for elderly people affected by dementia.

### 〈Long-term Preventative Care Communal Daily Living Care for People with Dementia〉

Communal living residence for elderly people affected by dementia and who require support. Daily life care, functional training and more services aimed at long-term preventative care are provided. Those with Support Care Level II certification are eligible.

Short-term intensive type support services provided by health and medical professionals aimed at improving movement ability.

### ●General Long-term Preventative Care Services

Services provided to all people over 65 years old. Educational classes regarding long-term preventative care and prevention of dementia are held.

Development approval is required for acts of development within the city’s urban area, as well as urban control area. Residential Land Development Construction Approval is required for residential land development and other activities within the residential land development construction regulated area.

## ●Procedures for Designated Activities in Accordance with the Environment Conservation Regulation

In order to conserve a favorable neighborhood environment, those conducting activities must introduce the planned activities to affected residents in an “advance public announcement”, “general explanation to affected residents” and “advance consultation” format.

## ●Subsidy for Earthquake Resistance Inspections of Privately Owned Buildings

Partial subsidies are provided for the cost paid by an owner to inspect a privately owned building for earthquake resistance and safety.

## ●Subsidies for Earthquake Resistant Designs and Repairs of Privately Owned Buildings

Partial subsidies are provided to owners of wooden housing for the costs of completing earthquake resistant designs and repairs.

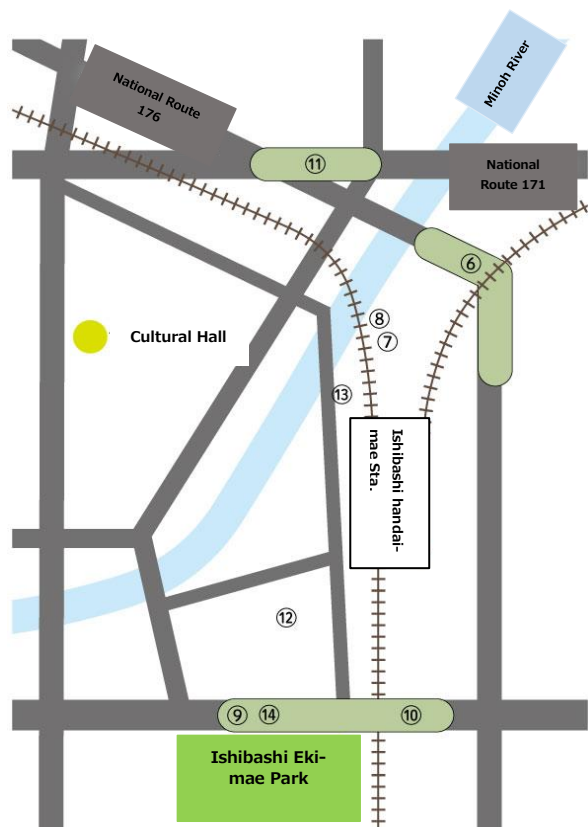

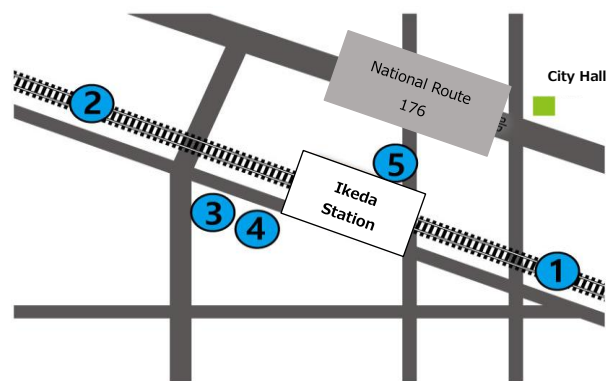
## Roads and Roadside Tree Management

### Dispose of Garbage Using the Designated Bags

A designated garbage bag system is being implemented to promote environmentally-friendly, sustainable urban development.

## Bringing in Garbage for Disposal

## [Waste Material and Recycling]

### ●Subsidy for Household Garbage Disposal Unit Purchases

Items subject to the subsidy include devices that regulate fluid of household food waste and reduce waste through microorganisms or heat, or composting electrical-type that treat food waste.

The subsidy will cover half of the cost of the purchase, or up to a sum of ¥30,000. It is limited to one device per household. A subsidy within budget will be provided.

### ●Subsidy for Purchase of Rainwater Storage Tanks

Rainwater tanks of more than 80 Liters in capacity that store rainwater from the roof of houses, are subject to the subsidy.

### ●Collection of Used Tempura Oil

### ●Raw Sewage Collection

#### ◎Regular Collection

For regular households, collection is 2 times per toilet waste tank per month. Collection for one household (up to 4 people) costs ¥500 per month (cost increases by ¥100 per additional person.).



### ◎Charge by Quantity

For regular household's simple flush type toilets, offices and business places, collection is 2 times per month. ¥240 is charged per 60 Liters.

### ◎Special Collection

For temporary toilets on construction sites. ¥5,000 is charged per toilet tank.

## ●Septic Tank Cleaning and Maintenance Inspections

To check if the septic tank is functioning properly, in accordance with the Septic Tank Laws, you are obligated to have it cleaned once a year and undertake maintenance and inspection four times a year. In Ikeda, cleaning work will be carried out following application. The cleaning cost is ¥8,000 for septic tanks of up to 1.5m<sup>3</sup> in size. The cost for septic tanks larger than 1.5m<sup>3</sup> is an additional ¥2,000 per 0.5m<sup>3</sup>. Maintenance and inspection costs ¥1,000 per inspection for septic tanks of up to 10m<sup>3</sup> in size. Septic tanks larger than 10m<sup>3</sup> in size cost ¥2,000.

## 【Pets and More】

### ●Pet Dog Registration and Rabies Vaccinations

Those with a dog older than 91 days must complete a one-off lifetime dog registration (¥3,000 registration fee), and vaccinate their dog for rabies once a year. Make sure to attach your dog permit and vaccination status (¥550 cost) to the dog's collar. Additionally, the dog owner must take responsibility and clean up after dog poo and other mess.

### ●Subsidy for Stray Cat Sterilization and Castration Surgery

In Ikeda, to lighten the negative effects of stray cats in the neighborhood such as stray cat droppings, as well as reduce the number of unfortunate cats, subsidies are provided (within the budget) for sterilization and castration surgery of stray cats.

#### 【Subsidy Amount】

Half of the surgery costs (including tax) of up to an amount of ¥5,000 will be covered by the subsidy.

### ●Handling of Deceased Pets (Cats, Dogs, and more)

The bodies of deceased pets such as cats and dogs can be picked up for a fee of ¥2,000, or accepted directly at the funeral hall for a fee of ¥1,000. If you bring the body directly to the funeral hall, you can use the special pet farewell room. (limited to residents)

# **[Waterworks and Sewerage]**

## **Waterworks**

### **●Repairs**

If there is leakage from water pipes, water won't come out of taps, or if the tap water is muddy or impure, please contact the Water Supply Construction Division (Weekdays 8:45 am~5:15 pm). The Ikeda Designated Pipe Construction Association is also available for contact outside of these hours.

### **●Pipelines Can Also Freeze**

If the temperature goes below negative 4 degrees Celsius, water taps (faucets) and pipelines will freeze, which can cause them to rupture more easily. Use the following methods to prepare for winter.

Before it becomes winter, use adhesive cold protection material to cover the pipes and make sure that they are not directly in contact with the cold. When the pipes freeze and water stops coming out, put a towel or cloth over the frozen section and slowly pour lukewarm water over it. If you pour hot water over the pipe, it will heat up dramatically fast, which may cause ruptures.

### **●Abnormal Occurrences**

#### **◎Red Water**

Caused by rust from within the pipes flowing out. Leave the water running until it becomes clean.

#### **◎White Water**

Caused by air inside the waterpipe which has become tiny bubbles. Leave the water running until it becomes clean.

#### **◎Sounds Coming from the Pipes**

A sudden change of pressure within the pipes or damaged seals and such can cause the tap to make a rattling sound.

#### **◎Water Not Coming Out Well**

Rust blocks the waterpipe gauge strainer, and water cannot flow well.

#### **◎Water Leaking from the Tap**

The seal is old and worn.

# Municipal Government, City Assembly and Elections

## 【Provision of Information on the Municipal Government】

### ●Release of Government Documents

In accordance with the Ikeda City Freedom of Information Ordinance, anyone can request access to municipal government documents maintained by the city.

#### ◎Application Process

Submit the Municipal Government Document Access Request Application to the city. The application can also be submitted via the internet, FAX or the post. The municipal government information corner on the second floor of the city hall can be used at the time of receiving and viewing the documents.

#### ◎Viewing Period

The viewing request is valid within 15 days from the day approval is granted (day the Municipal Government Document Access Request Application reaches the city). However, when the viewing is required due to difficulties with paperwork or other justifiable reasons, there are cases when the period may be extended.

#### ◎Information Not Available to the Public

Information unavailable for viewing is as stipulated in Clause 7 of the Ikeda City Freedom of Information Ordinance (including private information, etc.)

### ●Release of Government Documents Containing Private Information

In accordance with the Ikeda Privacy Protection Ordinance, anyone can request access to documents maintained by the city containing private information about themselves.

#### ◎Application Process

Submit the Private Information Access Request Application to the city. At the time of application, please present personal identification (Driver's License, etc.) verifying that the documents containing private information are about the applicant themselves. The municipal government information corner on the second floor of the city hall can be used at the time of receiving and viewing the documents.

#### ◎Viewing Period

The viewing request is valid within 15 days from the day approval is granted (day the Municipal Government Document Access Request Application reaches the city). However, when the viewing is required due to difficulties with paperwork or other justifiable reasons, there are cases when the period may be extended.

#### ◎Information Not Available to the Public

Information unavailable for viewing is as stipulated in Clause 18 of the Ikeda Privacy Protection Ordinance (including private information of persons other than the applicant, etc.)

## ●Attending the Inquiry Commission and other Councils

The inquiry commission and other councils established by the city are, by regulation, open for public attendance (councils not available to the public also exist).

## ●Municipal Government Information Corner

Government documents regarding the city can be viewed at the municipal government information corner on the second floor of the city hall. Viewing is available during the city hall opening hours (8:45 am~5:15 pm).

## ● "A Town Made by Everyone" Donation Ordinance (*Furusato Nozei* (hometown tax))

A system where contributors can choose the project that they would like to support from 14 different options (you can decide on how the donation money will be used).

Once final tax return has been filed, a donation of a maximum of 20% of the residence tax per income basis can be donated through the *Furusato Nozei* (Hometown Tax) Donation Program (¥2,000 is subtracted from the initial amount). This is then deducted from the final combined residence tax and income tax payment. The tax reduction is limited to a maximum of 30% of the general income tax amount.

# **【City Assembly】**

## **●City Assembly**

A legislative assembly made up of 22 councilors chosen in the city assembly elections. As representatives of the citizens, the city assembly conducts investigations into whether the municipal government is conducting itself properly in regard to decisions about regulations, budgets, petitions and other important matters relating to the livelihood of citizens. Alongside releasing reports, the main role of the city assembly is to bring the citizens requests to fruition, making real proposals to the city, stating its opinions to the country and working towards their implementation. Regular sessions for legislative bills and more are held four times a year (March, June, September, December), and should it be necessary legislative bills can also be introduced at extraordinary sessions. However, a majority of matters corresponding to city administration will be decided upon after expert and detailed investigation by four established standing committees (general affairs, education and hospitals, public welfare, civil engineering and fire department affairs). Following adjournment of the regular session, the standing committee investigates matters that were not concluded, and conducts on-the-spot inquiries into matters relating to the relative committee. A special committee has been established to investigate into matters that will have a strong effect on the livelihood of citizens.

## **●Petitions and Appeals**

Both petitions and appeals are made by residents (possible for those living outside of Ikeda and corporations as well) to the city assembly regarding requests relating to the municipal government.

### **◎Petitions**

A written statement including the intent, reason, submission date, name and address of petitioner (name of corporation and representative person in the case of corporations), and stamped with a personal seal must be submitted to the assembly chairperson with a written introduction from a city assembly member including their name and official seal.

### **◎Appeals**

Submission is the same as for petitions, however an introduction from a city assembly member is not required.

## **●Attending City Assembly**

It is possible to observe the plenary session from the public gallery on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor and the committee session from the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the City Assembly Secretariat upon providing your name and address.

Sign language interpretation can also be made available when attending the plenary session.

If you wish to use the service, please apply in advance (generally at least 5 days prior to desired observation day) at the City Assembly Secretariat (**FAX 072-753-5414**).

## ●City Assembly Public Information

In order to inform citizens about the activities of the city assembly, the *Ikeda Shigikai Dayori* (Ikeda City Assembly News) is published 5 times a year (in January, February, May, August and November) on the first day of the month. There is also an audio version of the magazine, please make inquiries if you wish to listen to it.

## ●Viewing Session Proceedings

## What is a “*kakaritsuke-i*” (family doctor)?

A “*kakaritsuke-i*” or family doctor, is a local doctor that is available for all sorts of light consultation and examinations. They are a strong support for citizens, providing consultation on not only medical issues, but also health maintenance, caregiving at home and nurse visits, insecurities surrounding aging, and emotional troubles. When being hospitalized or undergoing surgery, *kakaritsuke-i* can also provide consultation and another source of opinion. Currently the Ikeda City Medical Association is developing the “*kakaritsuke-i* promotion program” at the request of Osaka Prefecture.

Taking into consideration the country’s social situation, aging population and limited medical funds, within the medical field, communication between hospitals and medical clinics, each faculty’s roles, as well as cooperation between individual clinics is becoming very important. This program strengthens the connection between your *kakaritsuke-i* and other doctors and hospital doctors beyond existing conventions, in order to provide more information and suitable medical treatment for everyone.

Through appropriate and prompt hospital introductions and hospital admissions, time and unnecessary costs will be reduced in the treatment of citizens, ensuring reliable medical treatment without worry.

Please trust your *kakaritsuke-i*. You can talk with them about anything, without holding anything back. Your *kakaritsuke-i* will answer to all of their abilities. Having a *kakaritsuke-i* throughout one’s life is a great thing.
