



Do you know about Medical ID (Emergency Information)?

Medical ID (emergency information) is a healthcare function installed in iPhones and Androids. If you set up your Medical ID, the person who gives you first-aid in an emergency will be able to access your important medical information without a passcode from the phones lock screen. For example information about allergies and illnesses, and people you wish to be contacted during a medical emergency can be set up.



Medical ID set-up process (for iPhone)

1. Open the Healthcare app and tap the summary tab.
2. Tap your profile picture in the upper-right corner.
3. Under "Medical Details" tap "Medical ID".
4. Tap "Edit" in the upper-right corner.
5. To make your Medical ID available from the lock screen, turn on "Show When Locked". In an emergency this gives information to people who want to help.
6. Enter health information like your date of birth, allergies, and blood type, etc.
7. Tap "Done".



Medical ID set-up process (for Android)

1. From settings go to "User" and tap on "Emergency Information"
2. Enter personal and health information (in particular including blood type and any medications you are using is recommended)
3. Tap "Contacts" at the top of the screen and enter "Emergency Contacts"



※ Because Medical ID (Emergency Information) can be accessed by anyone from the lock screen, if the phone is lost or stolen you risk that information being easy to access. Please understand the benefits and disadvantages of entering your name, address and contact information before setting up your Medical ID. Let's all set up our Medical ID, just to be safe!
